

Lyme Regis Museum

Covid 19 Risk Statement

From September 8th, 2020, Lyme Regis Museum will re-open to the public using an online booking system. This system will allow the museum to open to the public with a much higher degree of safety for visitors as well as our volunteers and staff.

Please Note:

1. Access to the museum will be limited to one group every 20 minutes. A group is defined as a 'family' of up to six people - including all children.
2. All visitors will be asked to use 70% alcohol hand sanitiser on entering the building.
3. The museum will have enhanced cleaning procedures, but we cannot guarantee that all surfaces are always clean.
4. The museum has limited interactives. Those that operate with a touch screen will be operational. Our popular Activity Cubes will not be available.
5. The museum will have a lavatory available for visitors. This lavatory is suitable for people with disabilities and has baby changing facilities. Please observe rigorous handwashing routines.
6. There is a lift for those who need it. Only two people may use the lift at any one time.
7. The museum building has several 'pinch points', we request that visitors show consideration to each other in these spaces.

We are aware that the situation with Covid 19 can change rapidly. We would request that all visitors be aware that the museum may need to respond to as yet unknown challenges. We remind you of the importance of regular handwashing, avoiding touching one's face and whenever possible, maintaining a safe social distance.

Visitors are very welcome to bring their own PPE.

Finally, if you do feel unwell on the day of your visit, please stay at home and take care of yourself!
