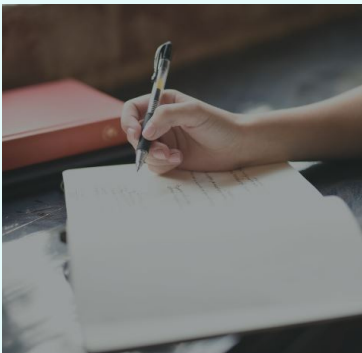




Nature and sky paintings
